Study Options for J-1/J-2 Students



Students interested in taking English language classes at Seattle Colleges while on their J-1 or J-2 visa have two options:

- Enroll in the Seattle Colleges Institute of English (SCIE)
- Take classes through Continuing Education

Note: Some J visa programs only allow for part-time study, so be sure to check your program requirements before enrolling.

Seattle Colleges Institute of English (SCIE)

<u>SCIE programs</u> are designed for international students who intend to enroll in a college or university. SCIE classes focus on helping students improve all aspects of the English language, including reading, writing, grammar, speaking, and listening. SCIE serves students across all three of our colleges, but classes are taught at Seattle Central College.

The <u>cost to attend SCIE</u> is fixed yearly. If you are interested in taking classes with SCIE, you must <u>apply for</u> <u>admission</u> through International Programs and submit your online admission application by the appropriate <u>deadline</u>.

Continuing Education

J-1 or J-2 visa students may also take English classes through <u>Continuing Education</u>. If you take classes through Continuing Education, you do not need to apply for admission to Seattle Colleges and you will not deal with International Programs at all.
